- **Two** current letters of recommendation must accompany all applications.
- A recent photograph to be used for publicity purposes - winners will be featured in Farm Bureau publications. **Please don't use staples** to attach the photo to the application. (No larger than 5x7)

Extra pages may be added if necessary. All applications need to be on the current 2024 scholarship application. Do not put applications in folders.
