

Weekly Hay Report June 20, 2022

First crop hay being laid down across the state with more expected this week. Even with the recent rains in the Northern region we had reports that they thought they would start this week. Producers there aren't concerned about the ground being too wet to lay hay down. They have done it before and they feel they can do it again. In the south the dry land producers are looking at a reduced crop with the combination of drought and frost hampering the maturity of the hay.

The market looks to be in the area of \$275 to \$300 per ton for clean and green in the stack. We did hear of hay trading at \$275 that had received a little shower but was still good enough for the export market. Supreme hay trading between \$335 and \$350 depending on the location.
