

Weekly Hay News April 15, 2019

The market in southeast Idaho saw supreme alfalfa trade at \$165 in the stack with the fair market at \$150. We are hearing of new crop contracts in the Magic and Treasure valleys running \$150 for hay testing less than 170 RVF. (all cuttings) New crop hay testing above 170 contracting at \$160. The Export market in Eastern Idaho is showing supreme at \$170, premium at \$155 and fair to good at \$140. Cold temperatures this past week hasn't put any premium into the market as for the most part the trade doesn't feel that any damage was done.

Export volume out of both California and Washington ports is currently higher than the same time frame last year.
