

## **Farm Bureau Reward Program**

(Effective 09-08)

### **PROTECTION**

Farm Bureau Mutual Insurance Company of Idaho agrees to pay a \$1,000 reward to the person(s) who furnishes information that leads to the arrest and conviction of any person or persons for **theft, arson, or vandalism**, on premises in Idaho or in connection with a motor vehicle or personal property owned by an eligible Idaho Farm Bureau member.

### **SIGNS**

Farm Bureau has reward signs available through the county offices. The first Farm Bureau reward sign will be given free to the member. Additional signs will be available at cost. Farm Bureau vehicle window reward stickers will be offered free of charge.

### **MEMBER ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS**

Farm Bureau membership dues must be current.

### **ELIGIBLE RECIPIENTS**

Anyone is eligible to receive the reward except:

1. Persons connected with any law enforcement agency or whose duties or occupation(s) include responsibility for law enforcement.
2. Employees or agents of Farm Bureau or its affiliates and their family members.

### **PAYMENT PROCEDURES AND CONDITIONS**

1. Anyone making claim for the reward must have supplied information to law enforcement that resulted in the perpetrator's arrest and conviction.
2. Those desiring information on collecting a reward should write to:

The letter should contain sufficient information to support the request for payment, including places, dates, names of all persons involved, and the appropriate law enforcement office. The Claims Department shall determine eligibility for payments.

3. Regardless of the number of persons qualifying, number of Farm Bureau members, number of criminal participants, number of crimes committed, or different types of property affected, a single \$1,000 reward applies per occurrence.
4. Any reward deemed payable shall be divided equally among all those who qualify as recipients.
5. New program applies to losses occurring after September 1, 2008.
6. Any posting of reward signage pursuant to the Farm Bureau Reward Program is subject to the terms of this program and cannot extend, expand and/or change the terms of this program.
