Theme: **Farm Safety**

New this year for 4th grade students. Computer art is acceptable, but it must be original art created by the student and not protected by copy-write. Fliers must not exceed 8 ½ x 11 inches in size.

Contest Purpose

To create a positive learning experience that promotes the importance of farm safety.

Judging Criteria

Be original using correct spelling and grammar. Be factual and appropriate for classroom use. Relate to Idaho agriculture in a positive way.

Entry Details

One entry per student to include a completed entry form. One student per entry. Limited to 4th grade students during the 2019-2020 school year. Counties will mail entries to their District Chairman. **INCOMPLETE ENTRY FORMS WILL NOT BE JUDGED.** Entries become the property of the Idaho Farm Bureau and will not be returned.

Deadline

Entry deadline from the counties to the District Chair is March 1st Counties will send their top three entries to the District Chair. Winners will be announced prior to the end of the school year

Prizes

- District Winner receives \$50, 2nd place receives \$35 and 3rd places receive \$25. Submission to the state finals.
- State Winner receives \$75, 2nd \$50 & 3rd Place receives \$25.
