

Weekly Hay Report January 10, 2022

In Idaho hay bids eased slightly this past week with Supreme quality bid at \$265, Premium \$250, Good and Fair bid at \$235. Bids were about \$5 less than the end of December but are still \$80 to \$100 higher than the previous year. Logistics remains a challenge in all Ag commodities with no real end in sight. You are able to get anything transported at any time if you are willing to pay the price. If you are waiting until you can get a deal on freight you may just be waiting a long time. The US export market has been good this year. Milk production is down but prices are fairly good for now.
